- Use proper English spelling and grammar and avoid using netspeak, and cryptic abbreviations - do not use all capitals as this is interpreted as yelling.

- You may not use this forum to sell products or services or to post links to other web sites with the main purpose of encouraging other members to purchase products or services.
- Do not post general thread titles. Please be as descriptive as possible when choosing a title for a new thread in order to maintain good organization and easier searching.
- Please use the search feature before starting a new thread. There is a chance your issue or question has already been addressed. If this is the case, instead of starting a new thread, try to contribute to the old one.
- Only start a new thread if posting in the old thread would be "hijacking". Hijacking is when you post something very off topic in a thread, pushing the entire discussion in a direction not intended by the original poster.
- Nothing illegal. No adult content, illegal drugs, politics, etc.
